- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 March 2023;
- Must have produced groundbreaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of religions;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

- Open for nomination: 23 September 2022;
- Nomination deadline: 31 March 2023;
- Winner announcement: 31 May 2023.
